Maria Baird convened the meeting at 10:00 a.m. The January 9th minutes were approved.

1. Update on Ross Valley Watershed Group efforts to reduce future flooding- Maria announced that the Town of Fairfax had officially joined Flood Control District 9.
2. Town Disaster Preparedness efforts-An electronic creek gage device has been installed behind the Youth Center to monitor water levels.
3. CERT Training update & “Get Ready” Program-Craig announced the next CERT training is scheduled for Sat. March 3rd & Sat. March 9th at College of Marin. The “Get Ready” program is exploring a county-wide grant for funding.
4. Blood drive-Gail reported that the blood drive was successful, with approximately 40 donors showing up, exceeding the minimum requirement. **CORRECTION: Gail stated that 22 donors had given blood.**
5. Home Safety Emergency Plan pamphlets:
Maria stated the brochures had come in, and have been delivered to all the locations that had donated towards the project. In addition, they are available at the library and Town Hall.
