One representative from the Town Council (Hartwell-Herrero), one from the Chamber of Commerce, one from Sustainable Fairfax, one from the Volunteer Board, and at least two members from the community at-large, with a maximum of nine total Committee members

All Boards, Commissions and Committees require that the appointed member must be a citizen of Fairfax, except for the Youth Commission which is open to Ross Valley youth and the Open Space Committee which allows members to live in the 94930 zip code area.

The Design Review Board requires that one member be an architect and that one member be in a design profession.

All members of the Commissions, Boards and Committees are appointed by the Town Council after the posting of a Notice of Vacancy by the Town Clerk at least 10 days before appointment.
